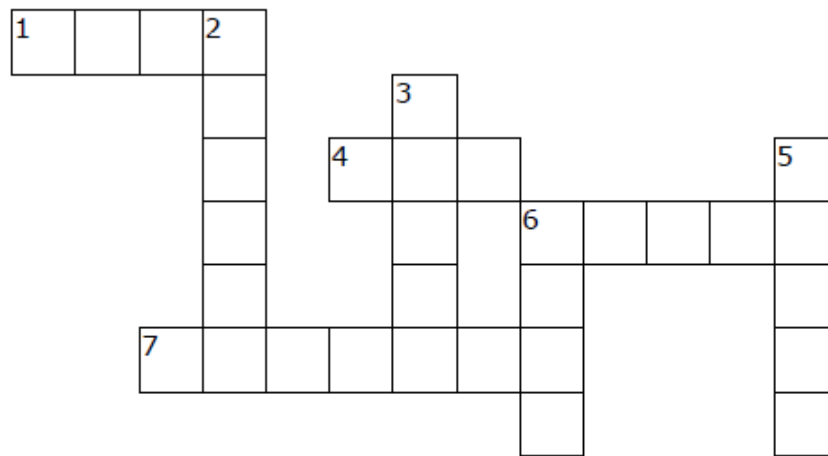
Revision of the Electoral Roll
