Now draw a picture of that part of the story.

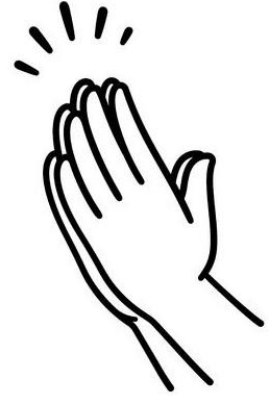
