# Story - from the Bible John 10:1-10 - The Good Shepherd

The Good Shepherd cares for his sheep and keeps them safe and away from danger, and he calls them by name and they follow him.

Jesus is our good shepherd he looks after us all the time and he knows us by our name – when we were born our parents spent time thinking about what to call us, it's our special name chosen for us and when we were Christened that name was also used, that's the name that Jesus knows us by. We were christened into the family of the church and we follow Jesus, just like the sheep follow the Shepherd.


#### **Activities**

# **Sheep Masks**

Make a sheep mask. There is a template at the end or make your own. Colour them in, add wool and use a ribbon to tie.

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Sheep Cup Cakes - see the recipe at the end



#### **Shepherds Staff**

This is an important piece of equipment to a shepherd, they us this to help them walk up hills and mountains or to help them rescue sheep that have got themselves stuck in bushes or on ridges. You may have seen a Bishop carry a staff, this is because he is looking after his flock which is us. He does this for Jesus.

#### You will need

Strong Cardboard / White paper / Colouring Pens / Scissors / Glue

#### What to do

Open up the box and join the pieces together to make a long piece of cardboard.

Then get an adult to help you draw a Staff on the cardboard and then help you cut it out.

Then cover the staff with white paper and draw a design on the staff and you can also write messages or bible verses. Maybe write a list of all the people who care about you and use in your prayers to say thank you.

#### Sheep Pen

Our younger members may want to play at being a shepherd.

You will need - some building blocks or lego / Cotton wool balls

Or you may have some toy sheep in the house.

Build a pen with the building blocks and then add the sheep or cotton wool balls in the pen. Have fun!!!

# Make a Sheep

You will need - Wool (sheep are not just white, choose any colour) / Card

2 pens / Black permanent marker or felt tip / White paper and or Black paper / Glue

What you do - Cut out an oval body shape. Take the two pegs and colour them with Black pen. Then attach them on one side of the oval Then draw and cut out a face for the sheep (with in black paper or white paper and colour it in) and stick it on one end of the oval (body) then take the wool and wind it round the oval until its covered and fluffy.

Thank you, God for everyone who cares for us thank you for all they do for me and the love they show. **Thank you, God.**



### Recipes -

Sheep Cup Cakes - Make a basic cake mixture

Recipe - 115g Butter / 115g Sugar / 115g Flour / 2 eggs / Small marshmallow

Icing sugar / Brown icing (optional) / 8 cake cups

Oven Temp 180c/350F/gas mark 4

Method

Cream the butter and together until smooth and creamy

Then mix in two eggs, then fold in the flour until all the flour disappears. Add a few drops of vanilla Essence (optional)

Then share the mixture into the cake cups and place on a tray. Place in the oven for 12-15 mins.

Put the cakes to rest and cool

Now mix the icing Sugar to a thick paste by adding water to the Sugar. Then spread it on the top of the cakes, now use the mini marshmallows to make the body of the sheep now add some food colouring to the rest of the icing sugar and make a face or some eyes for the sheep. Leave to set and then enjoy.
